



Dwyer bourdon tube pressure switches offer the accuracy and repeatability that diaphragm switches cannot provide. Their low deadband characteristics are ideal for pump sequencing.

The DA Series is equipped with two external adjustments. One sets high pressure operating point, the other sets reset point. Deadband, or the difference between set and reset points is adjustable over the full scale.

Features include: Visible calibrated dial, on/off indication, and SPDT snap-action or sealed mercury switches. Minimum deadband is obtainable at any point in range. Pressure Ranges vacuum to 5000 psig. U.L. and C.S.A. listed. Many models FM listed.
